

About University of Hull

The University of Hull is a public university, founded in 1927 and is situated in the leafy residential suburb of Newland, just two miles north of the city centre. The University of Hull is one of the most attractive academic campuses in the UK. The city of Hull is in the East Riding of Yorkshire, on the northern shore of the Humber Estuary, with good road links to the major cities of England. Hull is 200 miles from London, 100 miles from Manchester and around 60 miles from Leeds.

Description of the Program

This is a four year degree program with international exposure. In the first 3 years of study, students will do their courses at PSG, the academic curriculum being the same as that of Anna University courses offered by PSG.

The credits earned in the first 3 years at PSG will be transferred to the University of Hull. Students should also pass TOEFL with more than 80 marks out of 120 or IELTS with more than 6.0 to qualify for UK Student Visa to take up their 4th year of study. In the 4th year of study students can select their courses of study from the prescribed list and do the project thesis as part of the curriculum. After successful completion of the course, B Eng Degree in Mechanical (Accredited by the IMechE and IET, UK) will be awarded by the University of Hull. Those with good academic records can continue for M.Sc in the relevant field.



Program Objectives

At the end of the program

1. Graduates will have the technical skills and will assume executive positions in the respective areas of Mechanical, Automobile or Manufacturing Engineering.
2. Graduates will have the technical background in the analysis, applied design, development, implementation, and supervise / guide in the respective areas.
3. Graduates will exhibit an understanding of the necessity for personal integrity, ethical behavior, cultural awareness and lifelong learning.
